**International Broadcasting Board of Governors/Voice of America  
Next-Generation Newsroom Installation On-Target**

Norcross, GA, April 15, 2005 – The installation and implementation of NewsFlow, the tape-less news workflow system from Technical Innovation and Video Technics, at the International Broadcasting Board of Governors (IBB)/Voice of America headquarters in Washington, D.C. is progressing smoothly and is expected to be completed on-time and on-budget. A June 1 date has been set for system completion.

The new system will allow IBB to ingest feeds from around the world, permit editing and browsing by up to 60 journalists in the central operations center, and will provide multiple high-resolution finishing stations and 15 outgoing video feeds. At this time, preliminary acceptance testing has been completed, equipment has been deployed to the jobsite, and on-site installation is in progress.

Michael Wright, Vice President of Technical Innovation's Broadcast Solutions Group states, "We're pleased with the progress on this project, and look forward to a timely completion. When finished, IBB/Voice of America will have one of the largest non-linear news production and transmission systems in the world."
